Extension Activity

>> Helping Verb Bingo

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 19** - Photocopiable from page 140
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each pair a copy of Activity Sheet 19, a pouch and scissors.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the sentence cards at the bottom and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of the cards in the pouch. Each student keeps a table made up of helping verbs.
- ④ In turn, students draw a sentence card from the pouch, choose one of the corresponding helping verbs, and circle it in the table.
- ⑤ The student who first circles four helping verbs horizontally, vertically, or diagonally wins the game.
