



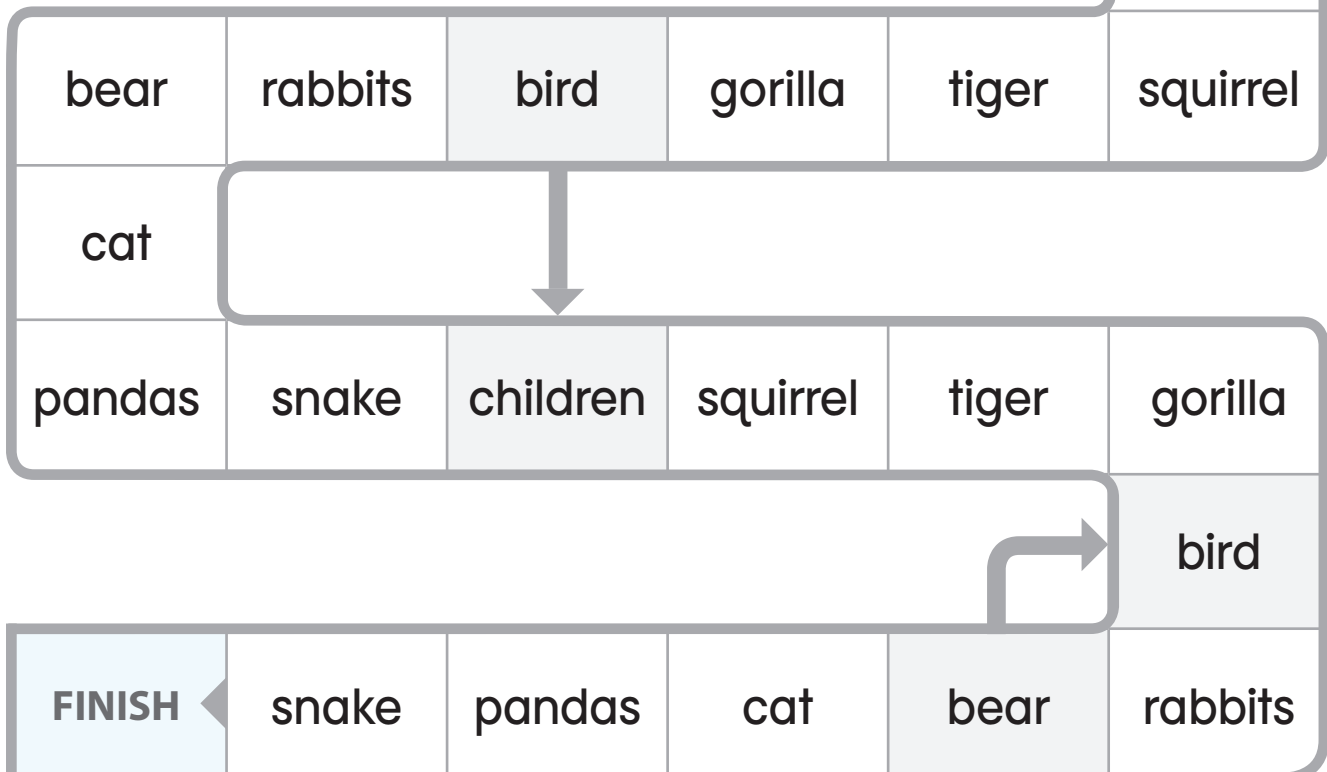

Extension Activity

>> Preposition Board Game

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 18** - Photocopiable from page 139
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a die and two counters (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Pair up students and give each pair a copy of Activity Sheet 18, a die, and two counters.
- ② Place the game board in the center of the desk. In turn, students roll the die and move their counters. When an odd number is rolled, they can move their counter one space. When an even number is rolled, they can move two spaces. When landing on a square where an arrow starts, go forwards or backwards to the square indicated by the arrow.
- ③ Students read the words in the square and look for the matching animals or people in the big picture. Then, they say where they are using the noun subjects and the prepositions of place. For example, *The children are in the sandbox.*
- ④ The student to first reach FINISH wins the game.

Possible answers

- The children are in the sandbox.
- The squirrel is behind the tiger.
- The tiger is in front of the slide.
- The tiger is in front of the squirrel.
- The gorilla is on the slide.
- The gorilla is in front of the bird.
- The bird is on the slide.
- The bird is behind the gorilla.
- The rabbits are under the slide.
- The bear is behind the green tree.
- The cat is behind the yellow tree.
- The pandas are in front of the swings.
- The snake is on the swing.
