## Extension Activity

### >> Sleeping or Not Sleeping?

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 15** - Photocopiable from page 136  
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 15.
  - ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
  - ③ Students cut out the cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
  - ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a card and saying whether the animals or people are sleeping or not.
  - ⑤ When they are sleeping, students say, for example, *The bat is sleeping*. When they are not sleeping, students say, for example, *The children are not sleeping. They are dancing*.
  - ⑥ When performed successfully, students win the stars.
  - ⑦ The student with more stars wins the game.
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### Answers

- 1 The mice are sleeping.
- 2 The bat is sleeping.
- 3 The owl is sleeping
- 4 The boy is sleeping.
- 5 The children are sleeping.
- 6 The man is sleeping.
- 7 The girl is sleeping.
- 8 The man is not sleeping. He is cooking.
- 9 The girl is not sleeping. She is crying.
- 10 The children are not sleeping. They are dancing.
- 11 The boy is not sleeping. He is swimming.
- 12 The owl is not sleeping. It is eating.
- 13 The mice are not sleeping. They are running.
- 14 The bat is not sleeping. It is flying.
