Extension Activity

>> Take a Guess

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 10** - Photocopiable from page 131
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 10.
- ② Pair up students. Have them take a guess whether their partner did or didn't do the activities listed and circle **Yes** or **No** in *Your Guess* section. Make sure they don't see each other's activity sheets.
- ③ In pairs, students take turns carrying out the following dialogue. Then, they circle **Yes** or **No** in *Your Partner's Answer* section.
S1: Did you get up early yesterday?
S2: Yes, I did. / No, I didn't.
- ④ When finished, ask students to count their correct guesses and write the number at the bottom of the sheet.
- ⑤ The student with more correct guesses wins the game.
