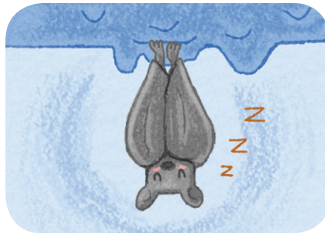

Extension Activity

>> Sleeping or Not Sleeping?

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 4** - Photocopiable from page 125
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 4.
 - ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
 - ③ Students cut out the cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
 - ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a card and saying whether the animals or people are sleeping or not. For example,
The owl is sleeping. /OR/ The owl is not sleeping. It is hunting.
 - ⑤ When performed successfully, students win the stars.
 - ⑥ The student with more stars wins the game.

Answers

- 2 The bat is sleeping.

- 5 The children are sleeping.
- 6 The mice are sleeping.

- 9 The girl is not sleeping. She is doing homework.
- 10 The children are not sleeping. They are dancing.
- 11 The mice are not sleeping. They are eating.
- 12 The woman is not sleeping. She is watching TV.
- 13 The owl is not sleeping. It is hunting.
- 14 The bat is not sleeping. It is flying.
