Extension Activity

>> Roll and Write

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 2** - Photocopiable from page 123
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a die and two counters (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 2.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a die and counters.
- ③ Students take turns rolling the die and moving their counters on their own game board. When an odd number is rolled, they can move their counter one space. When an even number is rolled, they can move two spaces. They can start from any square on the board and move their counters clockwise as the arrows indicate.
- ④ Using the words in the squares, students fill in the blanks under the appropriate pictures. There are eight squares with the words that can be used, and the remaining eight squares have the words that can't be used.
- ⑤ The student to fill in all the blanks first wins the game.
