>> Read and Circle

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 12** - Photocopiable from page 133
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 12.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the picture cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of picture cards in each pair's pouch.
- ④ In pairs, students draw a picture card from the pouch and read the sentence as they fill in the blank with an appropriate adverb. Then, they circle the adverb in the table.
