Extension Activity

>> Compare and Take the Cards

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 16** - Photocopiable from page 137
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 16.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the picture cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of picture cards in each pair's pouch. Tell students noncount noun cards can beat count noun cards.
- ④ In pairs, students draw a card from the pouch, say what they have, and compare. For example, *They're eggs. It's cheese.* Then, the student with the noncount noun card (cheese) takes their partner's count noun card (eggs).
- ⑤ If both students have the same kind of nouns, they put the cards aside and repeat step 4. The next winner takes these cards.
- ⑥ Play until all the cards are drawn from the pouch. The student with more cards wins the game.
