## Extension Activity

### >> Ask Your Partner

- Materials:
  - **Activity Sheet 3** - Photocopiable from page 124  
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- How to play:
  - ① Make a copy of Activity Sheet 3 for each pair. Cut the activity sheet along the line in the middle before class.
  - ② Pair up students. Give the Student A part to one student and the Student B part to the other. Make sure they don't see each other's activity sheets.
  - ③ In pairs, students take turns asking for the information to fill in the chart. For example, *Does Lucy drink milk? No, she doesn't*. To get the information about their partner, they should ask, for example, *Do you drink milk?*
  - ④ If you prefer, this activity can be played as a pair competition. The first pair to fill in the chart together wins the game.

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### Questions and Answers

- 1 Does Lucy drink milk? No, she doesn't.
- 2 Does Lucy get up early? No, she doesn't.
- 3 Does Lucy play video games? Yes, she does.
- 4 Does Lucy do the dishes? Yes, she does.
- 5 Does Willy drink milk? Yes, he does.
- 6 Does Willy get up early? Yes, he does.
- 7 Does Willy play video games? No, he doesn't.
- 8 Does Willy do the dishes? No, he doesn't.
- 9 Do Ben and Ken drink milk? Yes, they do.
- 10 Do Ben and Ken get up early? No, they don't.
- 11 Do Ben and Ken play video games? Yes, they do.
- 12 Do Ben and Ken do the dishes? No, they don't.
