Extension Activity

>> Match and Take

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 11** - Photocopiable from page 132
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 11.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the word cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
Take one card out of the pouch and put it face up on the table.
- ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a card from the pouch and reading it. If there is the opposite adjective card on the table, they pick it up and read the word. Then, they can take both cards. Otherwise, they place the card face up on the table.
- ⑤ The student with more cards wins the game.
