Extension Activity

>> Did or Didn't

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 8** - Photocopiable from page 129
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 8.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the picture-word cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
- ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a card. When a Yes card is drawn, they can take the card after saying, for example, *He listened to music yesterday*. When a No card is drawn, they discard the card after saying, for example, *He didn't practice the violin yesterday*.
- ⑤ The student with more cards wins the game.

Answers

- 4 He didn't cook dinner yesterday.
- 5 They walked to school yesterday.
