Extension Activity

>> Will or Won't

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 5** - Photocopiable from page 126
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 5.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the picture-word cards and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
- ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a card. When a Yes card is drawn, they can take the card after saying, for example, *He will play basketball tomorrow*. When a No card is drawn, they discard the card after saying, for example, *He won't play soccer tomorrow*.
- ⑤ The student with more cards wins the game.

Answers

- 1 It will snow tomorrow.
- 2 It won't rain tomorrow.
- 3 He will play basketball tomorrow.
- 4 He won't play soccer tomorrow.
- 5 He will go swimming tomorrow.
- 6 He won't go shopping tomorrow.
- 7 They will do homework tomorrow.
- 8 They won't do the dishes tomorrow.
- 9 She will eat cookies tomorrow.
- 10 She won't eat ice cream tomorrow.
- 11 She will write an email tomorrow.
- 12 She won't write a letter tomorrow.
