## Extension Activity

>> Ask Your Partner

- Materials:
    - ① **Activity Sheet 20** - Photocopiable from page 141  
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
  - How to play:
    - ① Make a copy of Activity Sheet 20 for each pair. Cut the activity sheet along the line in the middle before class.
    - ② Pair up students. Give the Student A part to one student, and the Student B part to the other. Make sure they don't see each other's activity sheets.
    - ③ In pairs, students take turns asking for the information to fill in the chart. For example, *What did Mr. Baker do yesterday? He read a newspaper.* Then, they write the answer as a complete sentence in the blank square.
    - ④ If you prefer, this activity can be played as a pair competition. The first pair to fill in the chart together wins the game.
