Extension Activity

>> Preposition Board Game

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 18** - Photocopiable from page 139
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a die and two counters (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Pair up students and give each pair a copy of Activity Sheet 18, a die, and two counters.
- ② Place the game board in the center of the desk. In turn, students roll the die and move their counters. When an odd number is rolled, they can move their counter one space. When an even number is rolled, they can move two spaces. When landing on a square where an arrow starts, go forwards or backwards to the square indicated by the arrow.
- ③ Students say the sentences using the prepositions in the squares. For example, *There is a mouse in front of the clown.* *There are lions on the drums.* Ask students to use the words in the word bank when necessary.
- ④ The student to first reach FINISH wins the game.

Possible answers

- There is a mouse in the cannon.
- There is a mouse under the elephant.
- There is a mouse on the elephant.
- There is a mouse next to the lion.
- There are lions on the drums.
- There is a mouse under the fire ring.
- There is a mouse in front of the clown.
- There is a bear behind the clown.
- There is a monkey behind the bear.
- There is a mouse behind the monkey.
- There is a mouse near the ball.
- There is a mouse on the swing.
- There is a mouse in the box.
