Extension Activity

>> There Is or There Isn't

- Materials:

- ① **Activity Sheet 1** - Photocopiable from page 122
(Also printable from Teacher Resource CD)
- ② a pouch/bag and scissors (per pair)

- How to play:

- ① Give each student a copy of Activity Sheet 1.
- ② Pair up students and give each pair a pouch and scissors.
- ③ Students cut out the word cards at the bottom of the sheet and put them in the pouch. There should be two sets of cards in each pair's pouch.
- ④ In pairs, students take turns drawing a word card from the pouch. Then, they look at the big picture and say whether the item is in the living room or not. For example, *There is a TV in the living room. There aren't any cats in the living room.* If the item is in the living room, they can take the card. If not, they discard the card.
- ⑤ The student with more cards wins the game.
