Scene 1 Hero or Not

Mole rides his bike to the park and sees Fox flying kites.

 : It's too windy today. My kites are not flying well.

 : I can help you!

 : Are you a hero?


 : Yes, I'm Mole the hero!

Mole takes the ropes and bites them. The kites fly away.


 : Oh no! My kites are flying away.

 : [sadly] I'm sorry.

Mole rides his bike and sees a beehive.

 : We need to make a new home.

 : I can help you!

 : Are you a hero?

 : Yes, I'm Mole the hero!

Mole tapes the holes on the beehive.


 : Oh no! Now our home is closed.

 : [sadly] I'm sorry.

Scene 2 Mole to the Rescue!


Mole takes his bike to a beach and sees Mule in a dune.

 : Oh, it's okay. I don't need your help.

 : I can help you! I'm Mole the hero!

Mole digs a hole and helps Mule escape.

 : Wow! You can dig a big hole.

 : Yes, I can.

 : You really are a hero!

 : [happily] I'm a hero now!
